

# Richard Bowdon

## Singer-Songwriter



A prolific singer-songwriter over four decades, Richard Bowdon carries forward the best Americana traditions, crossing freely over country, rock, blues, and folk, with a focus on well-crafted lyrics ... often ironic or humorous.

Over two decades in West Texas, Richard was selected three times for the Kerrville Folk Festival's New Folk songwriting competition, and his oil-field ballad *Back to Grand Rapids* got radio play.

In 1999 he relocated to the NC Triangle area, where he performs originals and covers, either solo or with his trio No Worries. Richard plays festivals, fairs, songwriter showcases, parties, restaurants, bars, coffee shops, bookstores, and conventions. Wineries and breweries too (go figure). He also records: three solo albums so far, plus two with No Worries.

In Richard's songs you'll hear echoes of John Prine, Townes Van Zandt, Guy Clark, Steve Goodman, Lyle Lovett, and other titans of Americana / roots music. Give him a listen!
